years, for example 1. has transferred IP from public university or public research institute based in
Slovenia (eligible types of agreements are 1. Research and development agreement, 2. Facility use /
service agreement, 3. License agreement, 4. Material transfer agreement, 5. Technical assistance
agreement), 2. has employed young PhDs from public research organisations (up to 30 years old) or 3.
has launched new products or services to the market (based on public-research based transfer and has
valid IPR or business secret protection);
Developing public campaigns to promote appreciation of their IP assets;
Encouraging creative and inventive activity among staff;
Creating corporate social responsibility programs to use the benefits of successful IP-based business for
public goals;

Executing commercial or marketing strategies based on effective use of the IP system.
