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THE AGENCY: History and Development

November 2004: Slovenian Research Agency (ARRS)

May 2023: Slovenian Research and Innovation Agency

(ARIS); legal successor of ARRS

Novelty: "Innovation" (originally managed by SPIRIT – Slovenia Business Development Agency)

• **Status**: legal entity governed by public law (established by the Government of the Republic of Slovenia and indirect user of its budget)




ARIS — Basic Facts

- Coverage: all research fields
- Types of research funded: basic and applied research, innovation (in process)
- Peer-review: exclusively by foreign reviewers and international panels
- Budget 2022: 274 mio EUR (state budget) + 148.634 EUR (EU budget)
- Budget 2023: 329 mio EUR




Annual Budget of ARIS (State Budget in EUR)

(in EUR, 2023)






Recent game-changers:

- **New** Scientific Research and Innovation Activities **Act** (2022)
- **New Ministry** for Higher Education, Science and **Innovation** (2023)
- New Slovenian Research and Innovation activity ARIS (2023) legal successor of ARRS
- New approach to research funding: block funding, 6-year cycle
- New approach to research assessment



Declaration on Research Assessment (aka San Francisco Declaration 2013)

- qualitative assessment of scientific research activities
- responsible use of bibliometric indicators (=/= criteria for evaluating scientific research activities and (individual) researchers)
- transparent method of calculating metrics
- wider range of evaluation criteria
- societal impact

Leiden Manifesto (2014)

- quantitative evaluation should support qualitative, expert assessment
- open, transparent and simple data collection and analytical processes
- performance is measured against the research **missions** of the institution, group or researcher
- encouraging publications in quality scientific journals of local interest
- qualitative assessment of individual researchers



Coalition for Advancing Research Assessment (2022)

- academic freedom and autonomy of research organisations
- diversity of research in science
- quality and impact of research in science and beyond
- open science principles and accessibility of results
- compliance with ethics, integrity and equal opportunities

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







BASIC CHARACTERISTICS:


- Six-year cycle (block/stable funding duration)
- Self-evaluation in the centre of the process
- 2 external evaluations
- Qualitative approach Peer review
- Fitness for purpose (mission, aims, strategy)




3 Types of Evaluation Six-Year Cycle of Block Funding


- 1. SEv Self-evaluation

- 3. IEv Institutional evaluation








Evaluation System (3 Types of Evaluation)







